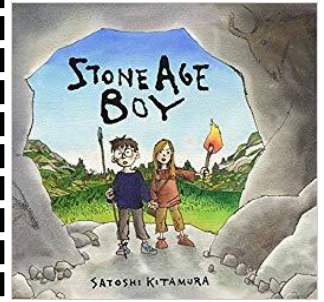


# SPRING 2 NEWSLETTER
