VOCABULARY IDEAS

Adjectives: spiky, forest green, turquoise, pointy, razor-sharp

Adverbs: menacingly, magnificently, furiously, quickly, ferociously

Prepositions: next to, between, opposite, underneath, above

Similes: as sharp as..., as terrifying as..., as spiky as...

Adverb: Carefully, Cautiously, Delicately,

Time: First, Next, Then,

Other suggested writing ideas:
